*Narrow down your college major choice.

*Register for the ACT/SAT **SPRING**

*Be sure you are acquiring volunteer hours to obtain scholarships.

*Retake the ACT/SAT to obtain required scores for college entry or scholarship opportunities. *Consider job shadowing a few professionals working in your dream career. Ask questions, take notes!
