*Speak to your guidance counselor to make sure you have all the credits, courses and test scores to graduate.

*Most college application early decision deadlines are in November. Check deadlines and application fees.

*Gather your financial documents. You will need them when applying for financial aid.

*Complete your personal essay. It can be used for scholarship applications and college.

*Gather necessary things for completing applications. Ex: Letter of recommendations, essays, etc. Don't wait until the last minute.

*Complete you FAFSA.

***Don't slack off!** Stay the course, colleges will review your final transcript.

*Look for private scholarships. Apply early.

*Register with FastWeb to begin searching for scholarships.

*Narrow down your college major choice.

*Retake the ACT/SAT to meet required score for college of choice

SPRING

*Apply for the Bright Futures Scholarship. Be sure you are meeting the volunteer hours requirement.

*Apply for local and national scholarships. Be on the lookout for a link.

***Don't get Senioritis!** Colleges want to see a strong finish.

*Request your transcripts to be sent to college of choice.

*Keep track of all acceptances, denials and financial aid awards.

*Be sure to contact the financial aid office at the college you select. Make sure all of your financial aid and course selections are completed in timely.
